Using qualitative research methods, the results show the musicians incorporate new elements into their music while still maintaining the '90s vibe, creating a synergy between nostalgia and innovation. Factors driving this creativity include the influence of popular culture, evolving music technology, and the desire to remain relevant in the ever-changing music industry. 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## INTRODUCTION

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to separate from some parts of society. Since ancient times, music has been an effective means of expressing the soul, carrying out religious rituals, entertainment, economic means, and can also be a means of conveying messages in communicating in society (Lestari, 2019).

The characteristics of entertainment music refer to the diatonic system originating from the West, while local characteristics are generally dominated by linguistic aspects (Muttaqin, 2008; Wahyuningsih & Sos, 2015). However, in traditional society there is also entertainment music which refers to traditional music idioms (Maula & Anggoro, 2024; Mutaqin & Kustap, 2007).

The main aim of this research is to understand the creative process used by musicians today in adapting and developing songs from the '90s era which includes the techniques, tools and approaches used. By understanding how today's musicians adapt '90s songs, this research can help identify trends and patterns in contemporary music. This research can provide valuable insight for the music industry into how past trends can be combined with today's music to create interesting and relevant sounds. The results of this research can be a source of inspiration for young musicians who want to learn how to combine elements from the music of the '90s into the work of today's musicians.

## METHOD

Qualitative research is research that intends to understand phenomena about what is experienced by research subjects, for example behavior, perceptions, motivations, actions, holistically, and by means of descriptions in the form of words and language, in a special natural context and by utilizing various natural methods (Ibrahim et al., 2023; Moeloeng, 2018). Qualitative research is research that is used to investigate, discover, describe and explain the qualities or characteristics of social influences that cannot be explained, measured or depicted through a quantitative approach (Anggito & Setiawan, 2018). According to (Sugiyono, 2019) Qualitative research method is a research method based on the philosophy of post positivism, used to research the conditions of natural objects, (as opposed to experiments) where the researcher is the key instrument, sampling of data sources is carried out purposively and snowballing, the collection technique uses triangulation (triangulation). combined), data analysis is inductive or qualitative, and the results of qualitative research emphasize meaning rather than generalization (Duryadi, 2021).

In this research, the method used is qualitative research. Qualitative research is used to deepen understanding of how musicians cultivate their creativity in adapting and developing songs from the '90s into today's context. Data was collected through in-depth interviews with several bands, namely the Diffunex band and the Ruang Putih band. Participatory observation in the creative process of making songs, as well as documentation studies in the form of song lyrics. Data analysis was carried out using content analysis techniques to understand the meaning and message conveyed in the song. It is hoped that

the results of this research will provide a deeper understanding of musicians' creative processes and how they interpret and adapt the nuances of the '90s into today's context.

Sylado (1983: 12) further said that music is a time to be heard. Music is a living form of time, which is a collection of illusions and sounds. Music that contains a series of soulful tones will be able to move the hearts of the listeners. From this opinion, it can be said that music is anything that is related to sound and has elements of rhythm, melody and harmony which create something beautiful and can be enjoyed through the listener's senses. It can be concluded that music is an art that arises from human feelings or thoughts as an expression of self-expression, which is processed into harmonious tones or sounds. If music is interpreted as a simple expression of the mood of the soul or a literal response to events from the composer's personal self, sufficient information or references are needed so that we can draw a direct connection between his life and his work (li & Teori, 2018)

### **Creativity Definitions**

Creativity is a potential that every human being has and is not received from outside the individual. The creativity that humans have is born with the birth of that human. Since birth, individuals have shown a tendency to actualize themselves. In this life, creativity is very important, because creativity is a very meaningful ability in the process of human life. It must be admitted that it is difficult to determine one operational definition of creativity, because creativity is a plural and multidimensional concept, so many experts have put forward definitions of creativity. According to Conny R Semiawan (2009: 44) creativity is the modification of something that already exists into a new concept. In other words, there are two old concepts combined into a new concept. According to Utami Munandar (2009: 12), creativity is: The result of interactions between individuals and their environment, the ability to create new combinations, based on data, information, or elements that already exist or are previously known, namely all the

experience and knowledge that has been created. acquired by a person throughout his life, whether in the school environment, family or from the community. Several techniques to stimulate creativity according to Nursito (1999: 34):

1. Active reading.
2. Likes to do research.
3. Actively appreciative
4. Love the value of art.
5. Respective of developments.
6. Produced a number of works.
7. Can provide examples of things that other people need.

Some of the explanations above can be stated that creativity is essentially a person's ability to give birth to something new, either in the form of an idea or real work, either in the form of new work or a combination of things that already exist, all of which are relatively different from what already exists. Previously (Darmawan, 2012).

### **Characteristics of Creativity According to Experts**

According to the Diagnostic Guidelines for Student Potential (Ministry of National Education 2004: 19) in Nurhayati (2011: 10), the characteristics of creativity include:

6. Sensitive to the beauty and aesthetic aspects of the environment.

According to Conny R Semiawan (2009: 136) the characteristics of creativity are:

1. Dare to take risks.
2. Play a positive role, think creatively.
3. Formulate and define the problem.
4. Growth and development overcomes problems.
5. Tolerance for double problems (ambiguity).
6. Respect each other and the surrounding environment.

According to Utami Munandar (2009: 10) the characteristics of creativity can be divided into two, namely cognitive characteristics (aptitude) and non-cognitive characteristics (non-aptitude). The cognitive characteristics (aptitude) of creativity consist of originality, flexibility, fluency and elaborativeness. Meanwhile, non-cognitive characteristics of creativity include motivation, personality and creative attitudes. Creativity, including both cognitive and non-cognitive characteristics, is an important potential to be cultivated and developed.(Darmawan, 2012).

## **RESULTS AND DISCUSSION**
